2025-2026 Sarnia Brigade Rep Registration Information

This budget was drafted by the executive as a net zero budget which means this is the actual cost determined to run each rep team within the organization. These costs were monitored and tracked over the past year. After financial review, it was noticed that the club covered 100% of the indoor costs last winter. This was not budgeted for when 2025 registration fees were set. Organizational changes were partly to blame for this oversight. That cost as well as the increase in the 2025 season operational costs have made us dip into our reserves.

Last season, our teams competed in nearly 550 games. The cost of umpire and diamond fees alone is projected to reach \$100,000 in 2026. Additionally, we plan to invest \$36,000 in tournament fees to ensure our teams continue participating in competitive out-of-town tournaments.

We have spent hours coming up with an all in cost which was not the case in the past. In the past we asked for registration to be paid to the organization, then asked for separate payments to be made for uniforms and indoor workouts. Here is a rough breakdown of last year costs:

2025 Registration Costs

14U-16U \$800 Registration + \$300 uniforms + \$220 indoor = \$1320 10U - 13U \$700 Registration + \$300 Uniforms + \$220 indoor = \$1220 8U - 9U \$550 registration + \$300 Uniforms + \$220 indoor = \$1070

These figures are estimates, as indoor training time varied between teams depending on facility availability. Throughout the season, we discovered that our initial projections were low, and actual operating costs exceeded expectations due to increased expenses for umpires, field rentals, equipment, and baseballs.

Some comparable registration costs for what the Brigade will be offering this season:

London Badgers – 10U-11U \$1800, 12U-13U \$2700, 14U-15U \$4500, 16U-18U \$5000 All inclusive fee very similar to what the Brigade is offering.
